Emulators, Simulators

An emulator is a program executing the ROM code dumped from a smartcard as close as possible as the processor in the smartcard would. An emulator can even apply patches on his "EEPROM image" like an original smartcard.

A simulator on the other hand interprets the commands received from the IRD and returns hardcoded replies. A simulator usually needs to be upgraded when the original smartcards are patched.
